**METRO MASS TRANSIT CONSOLES ROAD TRAFFIC CRASH  
VICTIMS**

An MMT bus was involved in a road traffic crash with a Toyota Corolla car with registration number GW 6924 W on Saturday, July 5, 2014 at Amangoase, a town located on the Sunyani-Techiman route.

On Sunday, July 6, 2014 it was reported that an MMT bus with registration number GE 3206-12 was involved in a road traffic crash with a Sprinter mini benz bus with registration number GS 3161-13.

Early this year, close to 2,000 drivers nationwide have undergone re-training organized by MMT and the National Drivers' Academy and since the training this is the first time such a major road traffic crash has occurred.

Whilst we leave the Ghana Police to do their own investigations, MMT will set up a committee to do in-depth investigations into both road traffic crashes.

MMT deeply regrets what happened and consoles all bereaved families of both road crashes whiles wishing those injured speedy recovery.

Meanwhile the company is dialoguing with our Insurers to pay insurance to those insurance is due.

All our cherished passengers are reminded that MMT remains the safest, reliable and efficient means of transport throughout the country after the company was awarded the Best Transport Company for 2013 by the National Road Safety Commission.

Passengers are advised to always insist on their tickets anytime they board an MMT bus.
