MMT ADJUSTS IT'S FARES NATIONWIDE

The Management of Metro Mass Transit Ltd. (MMT) will from Thursday, June 11th, 2009 adjust its fares upwards on its routes nationwide to reflect the fuel price adjustment by the National Petroleum Authority (NPA).

This adjustment which is intended to reduce the gap between fares charged by MMT and other operators follows the release of new fares by the Ghana Road Transport Co-ordinating Council (GRTCC).

MMT would like to assure its cherished commuters that MMT's **affordable fares still remain far below competition** despite this review.

The fare adjustment will affect about 280 routes being operated by MMT nationwide.

Our cherished commuters should look out for the displayed fares in the buses and at the various bus terminus.
